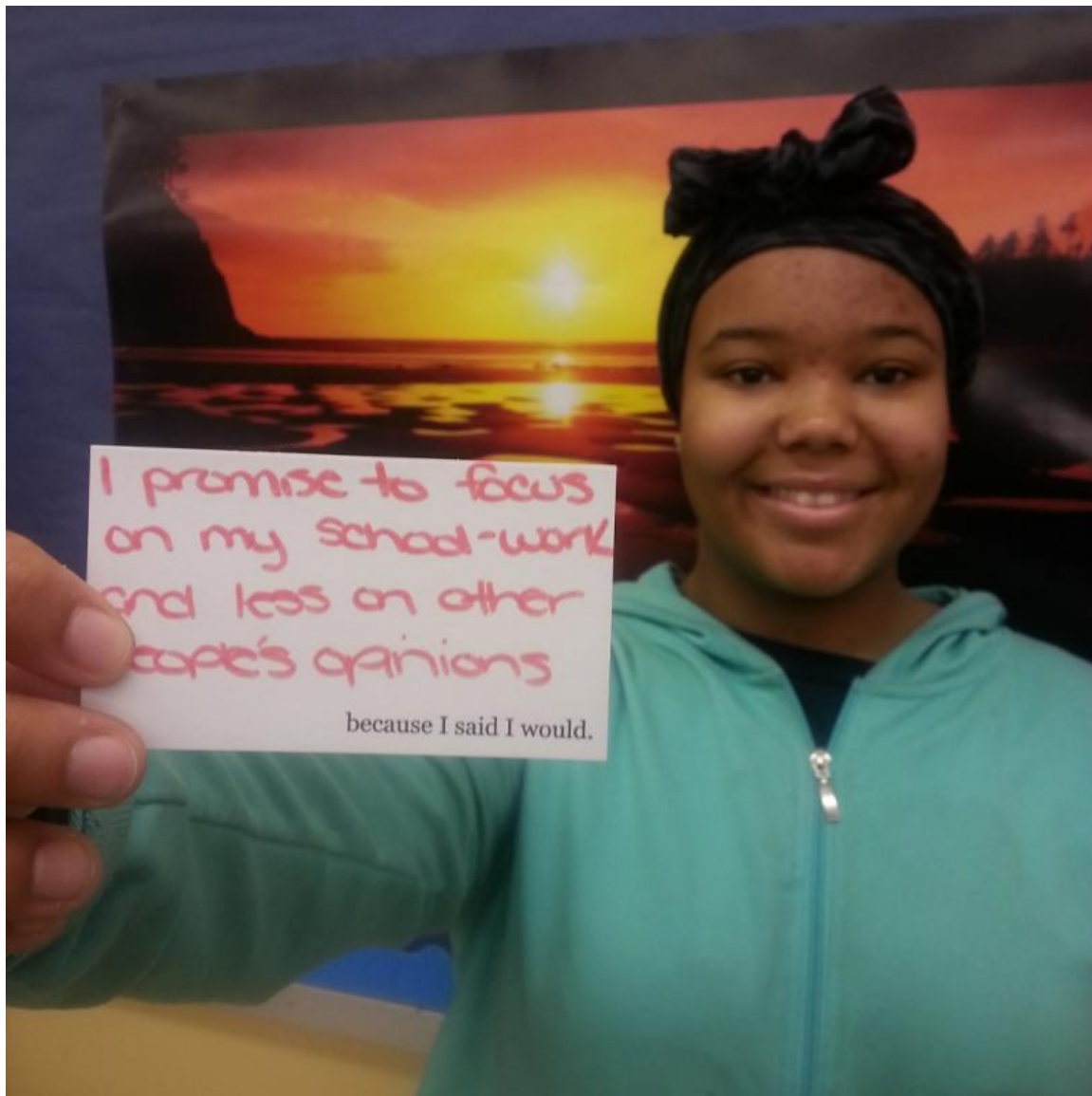
Learning English, Math and Science is incredibly important. But...
